

Comments: There is a recreation trail on the road in the parcel. I am at a loss why Fisheries classified this as non-development. None of the satellite imagery indicates water within the parcel and the parcel has been harvested and no buffers left to indicate the presence of water.

Comments: Young jack pine is found on this parcel. Wildlife Division requests that no work be done from June 1 to July 15 to protect any nests of neo-tropical migrants that may be nesting and fledging at that time. Of particular importance is the Kirtland's Warbler, a Federal endangered species, which has been documented within 2 miles of the parcel. Narrow-leaved gentian, a State threatened legally protected species, has been known to inhabit wetland areas in this section. Care should be given before clearing any sites.

Comments: For some reason, Kelley Smith (former Fisheries Chief) had placed a non-development restriction recommendation on this parcel during an 8-21-2003 review. Indeed while there is no water or aquatic resources on this parcel, with care and respect for the 2003 review I carried Mr. Smith's recommendation forward in case there was an element of uniqueness to this parcel that we are not aware of. For this 8-12-2014 review, I have changed Fisheries Division's recommendation to "development", with no restrictions.
